The Annual Spring Cleanup will be held on Saturday, April 27. Volunteers are always welcome, so come on down and bring your beach cleanup implements of destruction! We meet at Sandy Beach at 8:30 AM, then make our way around to all of the properties. It only takes us a couple hours with the help of some enthusiastic members (and some coffee and donuts). The rain date is Sunday, April 28.

The Opening Cookout is Saturday, June 22 at Sandy Beach. We're looking for donations such as desserts and salads (the Board of Directors will supply burgers, hot dogs, and some cold drinks). The party starts at 11:00 AM. The rain date is Sunday, June 23.

For the last several years we've combined the annual Bass Fishing Tournament with a Cornhole Tournament. Registration for the Fishing Tournament starts at 7AM at Sandy Beach. ## **Requests and Reminders**

**PLEASE CONTACT** the Westford Dog Pound directly at 978-692-4574 to report leash law violations on any of our N.I.A. properties.

**NO GLASS CONTAINERS** of any kind are allowed on any of the N.I.A. beaches. We ask that all members help to keep this rule enforced.

**BOATERS AND SWIMMERS** should respect No Trespassing of our abutters and stay within the N.I.A. fenced in areas.

**PARENT or GUARDIAN SUPERVISION** is required for all children under 12 years of age, and those with inner tubes.

**PLEASE DISPOSE** of smoking materials in the provided smoking receptacles. Smoking is restricted to the rear fenced areas of all beaches. Your cooperation is appreciated!

**PLEASE STOP** the spread of nuisance freshwater organisms. Clean organisms off boats, anchors, motors, and trailers before leaving ANY boat launch access area.



**PARKING OF BOAT TRAILERS** at the Sandy Beach parking area or along the access road leading to the beach is not permitted. Members are encouraged to bring their trailers home after launching their boat. Do not lend out your boat key. This will result in the loss of your boat key privilege. Thanks for your support on these issues.

## **Rules Pertaining to Beaches and the Water**



November 19, 2009

- N.I.A. Members and their guests only.
- Guests MUST be accompanied by a member at all times.
- Members may be required to show their card to a Director and must bring their card with them.
- All beaches are closed at 9:00 PM.
- Parent or guardian supervision required for all children under 12 years of age, and those using inner tubes.
- Use large inner tubes beyond markers.
- No animals allowed on beach areas.
- No littering.
- No use of soap or shampoo.
- No sand or rock throwing.
- No foul or obscene language.
- No hard baseballs to be used.
- No boat launching except at prescribed areas and during prescribed times.
- No glass containers on beach areas.
- No jet skis allowed. Strictly enforced.
- No wake within 100 feet of any swimming area.
- No boat key lending. Loss of boat key will result.

### **Nabnasset Improvement Association Boundaries**

South side of Route 40 (Chelmsford Line) from Chelmsford town line to Boston and Maine Railroad tracks to intersection with Depot Road. Plain Road to intersection with Nutting Road. From Nutting Road to intersection with Bobolink (Nutting Road #16). From end of Boblink following a straight line to intersection with Nabnasset Lake, following the western shoreline of Nabnasset Lake to Muriel Drive, following Lawson Road to intersection of Forrest Road; Forrest Road to intersection of Route 40 (House #434). House #434 Route 40 easterly on Route 40 to intersection of Chelmsford town line. This excluding all properties to the North of Route 40.
